

TMS Patient Selection

TMS THERAPY MDD INDICATION

TMS therapy is indicated for adult patients with moderate-severe Major Depressive Disorder that have failed antidepressant medication trials and who have not received benefit from psychotherapy

STANDARD INSURANCE CRITERIA

- MDD diagnosis (F33.2, F32.2, F33.1)
- 2 or more antidepressant trials
- Trial of evidenced-based psychotherapy

Who May Qualify for TMS Treatment?

- Tried or not satisfied with results of antidepressant medications
- Have not achieved remission with medications or therapy
- Unable to tolerate medication side effects
- Do not have a diagnosis of Bipolar Disorder, Bipolar Depression, Schizophrenia, Schizoaffective Disorder, or current Substance Use Disorder

TMS Therapy Contraindications

- Metallic implants in the head or within 30 cm of the head (exception: dental fillings and braces)
- History of a seizure disorder
- Implanted medical devices, such as a pacemaker or cardiac defibrillator
